Australian Technology Park Redevelopment Information about Tower Crane Installation

On Saturday 25th February 2017 Mirvac will be installing the first of 3 tower cranes for the development on Lot 9 at Australian Technology Park. The works will involve the setting up of a mobile crane within the Lot 9 / Building 1 footprint. (see attached drawing). The components for the crane will be delivered on trucks that will enter the precinct via Davy Rd and turning left onto Central Ave.

There will be exclusion zones in place on central Ave for short periods during lifting operations. Public pedestrian access will be maintained on Central Ave and access to the Media City carpark and loading dock will also be maintained.

The works are scheduled to be completed on the day however progress could potentially be delayed due to unforeseen circumstances such as inclement weather.

Subsequent Tower crane installation to Building 1 will be undertaken towards the end of March 2017. These dates will be communicated closer to the works.
