The International Business Centre building at ATP was part of the original construction of the Eveleigh Workshops in the 1880s. It served as the Work Manager's Office, Pay Office and Timekeeper's Office for the site. Notably, a bell on top of the building rang at the start and end of shifts to keep workers on time.

Construction Activities

Occurring September - October 2018

BUILDING 1

- Services rough-in to all floors.
- Installation of structural steel and roofing to Level 8 plantroom.
- Completion of external façade.
- Installation of internal passenger and goods lifts.
- Continuation of internal fitout works.
- Commencement of external works to Henderson Road.

BUILDING 2

- Continue structural steel erection and pouring of suspended concrete slabs.
- Installation of internal services for Level 1 and 2.
- Installation of internal lifts.
- Commencement of curtain wall installation.
- · Handover of Lower Ground substation to Ausgrid.

BUILDING 3

- · Continue structural steel erection, suspended concrete slabs and establishment of perimeter edge protection systems.
- Installation of external curtain wall.
- Continuation of internal service and fitout works.
- Removal of Tower Crane 3.

PUBLIC DOMAIN

- · Formwork, reinforcement and concrete installation works.
- New kerb and gutter, paving and tree pits to Central Avenue.
- Regrading and drainage works.
- Installation of new services
- · Commencement of Building 1 external works on Henderson Road.
- Landscaping including new planter beds.

ROAD AND FOOTPATH CLOSURES

- Pedestrians travelling through Innovation Plaza and the Entry Garden are to be diverted down Cornwallis Street footpath, however building access will remain open.
- One half of Vice Chancellor's Oval to be kept closed with footpath access to remain open. This is due to open by the end of September.
- Davy Road western footpath between the Sports Courts and Central Avenue to be closed.
- Central Avenue southern footpath between Davy Road and the western roundabout to be closed.
- Central Avenue northern footpath between Davy Road and Mitchell Way to be closed.
- Central Avenue northern will be closed during construction hours.
- Locomotive Street southern footpath between Mitchell Way and Central Plaza to be closed.
- Pedestrian diversions will be in place on Central Avenue outside the Media City building over the next two months. These diversions will enable the installation of a new kerb and gutter, street lighting, paving and landscaping. The taxi zone, loading zones and pickup and drop-off areas for the Media City building will remain in place at all times. Henderson Road landscaped area between the western boundary and the Sports Courts to be closed.
